Visits can be related to the current exhibition:

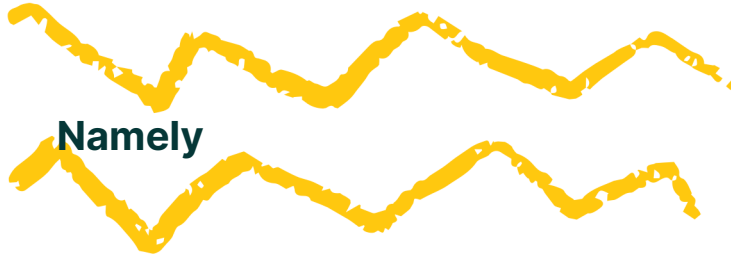
- Exhibition visit, media library tour and film screening themed around the exhibition

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Meeting with a work

Listen and watch IFC's videos. These short videos highlight the work of artists who have exhibited their works at the Institute. You can find these videos on the IFC website, Facebook and YouTube.



- A chaperone is required

The recommended number of chaperones is 1 adult for every 5 children (ages 5 to 10) and 1 adult per 10 children for older groups.

- Transport: the school or NGO supervises the students' movements and supervises them during these trips. It is possible to reserve the mini bus made available by the IFC, for this, a reservation is necessary in advance.

- Groups: 10 people maximum for the media library, 15 for the gallery, 80 for the cinema.

- Off-site activities : Custom off-site activities can be arranged upon request.



L'Institut français du Cambodge (IFC) is part of the global network of French institutes. Its main branch is in Phnom Penh, its second branch is in Battambang. The IFC opened its doors in 1990 under the name Alliance Française then the Centre culturel français. It took the name of Institut français du Cambodge in 2011.



L'Institut français du Cambodge offers an important multidisciplinary cultural and educational offering: music, theater, exhibitions, readings, cinema, cooking, etc. The IFC has a language center, a media library, a restaurant, an exhibition gallery, a cinema and a garden.

The Institute offers French courses to children, students, professionals and international organizations. It is accredited to pass and deliver international certifications such as DELF, DALF, TCF... It also offers numerous events and activities, actively participating in the national, regional, local and global cultural scene. The Institute also participates in events off-site and creates partnerships. It thus promotes culture and exchanges between France and Cambodia.

A public service was set up in 2021. It aims to facilitate exchanges and understanding between our French and Cambodian cultures. This service aims to offer tools for all audiences, particularly for school audiences.
